1 <u>**TITLE**</u>: Promotion of non-monetary benefits for clinical education experiences

2 3 <u>MOTION:</u>

- The American Council of Academic Physical Therapy (ACAPT) promotes the provision of non-monetary
 benefits to clinical education sites and clinical instructors (CIs) for providing clinical education experiences
 in entry-level physical therapist (PT) education.

- 8 Non-monetary benefits, unlike promotional materials, demonstrate an institutional investment in clinical
- 9 sites/instructors and advance clinical teaching and practice to ensure excellence in PT clinical education.
- 10 These benefits, which are provided in a non-cash form (e.g. certificate of service, continuing education
- 11 courses, guest lecture opportunities, library access, CI credentialing courses, research opportunities, tuition
- 12 vouchers), must be relevant, useful, and accessible to clinical education sites and clinical instructors.

- ACAPT supports, in collaboration with other stakeholder groups, further investigation to identify benefits
- 15 that are meaningful and easily accessible to clinical education sites and CIs.

- 17 ACAPT supports collaborative development and open access resource sharing among academic programs
- 18 to facilitate equitable access to and distribution of non-monetary benefits.
